• Guest speakers are asked to send the Museum the title and abstract of the paper they wish to present by June **5**, **2017**.

- The presentation must not exceed the time limit of 20 minutes.
- The Museum reserves the right to preselect suggested topics, should the number of the submitted proposals exceed the capacity. International speakers shall receive feedback within 5 days from the submission date; speakers from Poland will receive such a notification no later than June 10.
- The Conference is going to be held in the Museum and Education Center at The Casimir Pulaski Museum in Warka (sessions, coffee break, and lunch). Accommodation is provided by Sielanka nad Pilica Hotel and Klondaik Hotel in Warka. We provide shuttle service between the conference site and hotel.
- Participation in the Conference is free of charge.
